

## BIC Elementary, Intermediate, Middle & High School Dress Code for 2014-2015

### Jeans

1. All jeans must be blue. (Basic style with no designs or wrinkle-designs)
2. Cargo jeans are not allowed. (No extra pockets on the legs or hips of the jeans, etc.)
3. No decorative/logo or multi-colored stitching/embellishments on the pockets or pants.
4. Jeans may not be frayed, have any holes, rips, tears, or rolled cuffs. No flaps, zippers or buttons on the jean's pockets.
5. Jeans must stay up without a belt.

### Shirt

1. Shirts must be white, crew neck T-Shirts only- No Collars or Pockets. (V-Necks are prohibited)
2. Shirts can have short or long sleeves, but must be made from cotton, T-Shirt material.
3. Shirts cannot be worn inside out.
4. Shirts cannot have any visible writing or logos of any kind on them.
5. More than one shirt may be worn, but the same rules apply for the undershirts.
6. Any garments worn under shirts must be white. Colors, prints, etc. cannot be visible.

### Belt

1. Must be black, brown or white leather. (Cloth or fabric belts are not allowed)
2. No embellishments, no pictures or decoration on the buckles. (Basic belt buckles are allowed)

### Shoes

1. Athletic shoes only – no boat shoes, Sperry's, Vans, workbooks, steel toes, slip on etc.
2. Only shoes with white or black laces may be worn. (The laces must be basic black or white)
3. Only Elementary students may wear tennis shoes with Velcro fasteners.

### Accessories and Jewelry

1. No clips, bows, ribbons allowed. Bobby pins and rubber bands may be worn as necessary.
2. No jewelry allowed. This includes medal spacers, gages, and rubber bands.
3. No purses, book bags, or backpacks.
4. Jackets may only be worn in cold weather. Jackets are not permitted in the classrooms.
5. No distracting hairstyles or hair colors.
6. No tattoos. (All tattoos must be covered)
7. No body piercings; tongue included. Piercings must be removed and metal spacers are not allowed.

### ID Badges – High School students only

1. A current 2014-2015 ID must be worn at all times on a lanyard.
2. The student's photo, name, school name, grade and year must be clearly visible.
3. The ID must be clear of stickers, writing and damaged edges.
4. IDs will not be stored daily in the students' binders. It is the student's responsibility.

**Discipline-** 1 Suspension = student returns to level one and zero points. 1 Unsuccessful Day = 1 Additional Day. 3 Unsuccessful Days = Suspension; OSS, suspension days must be completed; student returns to Level 1 and zero points are earned for 1 period. Students who reassigned to BIC during the 2014-2015 will remain on Level 0 for the entire BIC assignment. I have read and understand the dress code and unsuccessful day policies.
